FINANCIAL POLICIES

Y-Cares Financial Assistance Program

The Freehold Borough YMCA will not turn away individuals due to their inability to pay. Financial assistance is available for individuals and families who demonstrate financial need. Please contact the Freehold Borough YMCA Community Center for a Y-Cares application.

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Payment Policy

A minimum \$25.00 non-refundable deposit is due upon registration. NO REFUNDS after week 1 of league play.

PLAYER AND PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES

In order to advance the principles of sportsmanship, fair play, and mutual respect among players, coaches, referees, and spectators, the Colonial Basketball operates with the following expectations:

Families involved in the Colonial Basketball League recognize the time and effort commitment that is required to have a positive experience upon registering for the program. Youth participants need the support of adults to ensure that they are prepared to do their best at all times.

Youth participants and their supporters understand that they are representing not only themselves, but the Freehold Borough YMCA Community Center when at host facilities for practices, games, and special events. Facilities and equipment should be left in the condition in which they were found.

Players must arrive to practice 10 minutes prior to the scheduled start time and be prepared wearing with the proper attire: shorts, t-shirt, sneakers, and with bottled water or other hydration. Parent/guardian must communicate anticipated tardiness with a coach.

Players must be picked up no later than 10 minutes after the conclusion of their team's practice and/or game. This is to ensure the timely beginning of other team activities and the closure of Freehold Borough Public Schools.

Team Coaches are YMCA Volunteers and therefore not permitted to transport youth who do not reside with them. Players are not permitted to bike or walk home alone. Please plan transportation and carpools accordingly.

Players who miss practice the week before a game without prior written notice to the coach and Program Coordinator will only be permitted to play in 1 quarter of that week's game.

Players are expected to attend and actively participate in all practices and competitive activities. Players must be present at least 80% of the season's practices and games in order to be eligible to play in playoff and championship games. Notice of possible ineligibility will be given in writing two weeks prior to playoff weekend.

Children are not permitted to attend practices and/or games without adult supervision. Team Coaches are responsible for registered participants during scheduled practices and games. Please do not leave children who are not league participants unattended at league events.

Players who do not attend school will not be permitted to participate in the next scheduled league activity without written explanation as to why school was missed but participation in basketball activities is permitted. This includes missing school the day of a practice or on Friday before a game on Saturday.

If a player misses a practice or game due to illness/injury, a note on physician letterhead confirming their health is required before the player will be permitted to continue participation in the league. No casts, neither hard or soft, or hard supportive braces on any body part will be permitted during practices or competitive play for the protection of all participants.

While a specific grade point average is not a requirement of participation, academic progress is a vital part of youth development. Any Colonial Basketball League player who needs extra assistance with their academics is encouraged to contact their Guidance Counselor and the YMCA to determine the best course of corrective action. The YMCA can potentially connect youth with high school students who can assist with extra help at no cost to the player's family.

NOTICE OF UNACCEPTABLE BEHAVIOR

In accordance with the YMCA of Greater Monmouth County Member Code of Conduct, the following actions and behaviors are not permitted during Colonial Basketball League activities:

- Acting in a confrontational and/or threatening demeanor regardless of who it is directed at
- \bullet Profane, disrespectful, and discouraging language regardless of who it is directed at
- Unsportsmanlike conduct including humiliating or taunting a fellow athlete or coach
- Challenging game officials in a disrespectful tone and/or manner
- Failure to remain tobacco, drug, and alcohol free at YMCA/CBL events

Parents, guardians, and spectators are expected to cooperate and encourage appropriate behavior from participants. Any person in violation of these expectations shall be subject to administrative action, up to and including losing the privilege of participating in and/or attending any Colonial Basketball League event. YMCA of Greater Monmouth County staff has the authority to make decisions regarding the immediate removal of any participant and/or spectator whose conduct is detrimental to the program.

Violations by a league player will result in the following consequences:

- Violation 1: Verbal warning from Coach/YMCA staff or volunteer
- Violation 2: Written warning from Program Coordinator
- \bullet Violation 3: Suspension from one game and parent/guardian meeting with YMCA Director
- •Violation 4: Expulsion from remainder of Colonial Basketball League season without refund
