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LEADERSHIP TRAINING PROGRAM

WHAT IS THE LEADERSHIP TRAINING PROGRAM ALL ABOUT?

The Leadership Training Program is designed to give selected high school students (14-15 years of age, grades 9 and 10) the opportunity to learn and develop leadership and program skills while in the Summer Day Camp Program. This program is for those campers who are interested in learning about leadership and responsibility. The program consists of training and actual work experience with a small group of campers under the supervision of a YMCA staff person. Maturity and a sincere desire to work with children are essential. It is about discovering what you are capable of and finding your inner leader!

THE PROGRAM

This is an eight-week program. Through supervised group leadership opportunities, LT's learn the skills and responsibilities necessary to become a leader by participating in all camp events. While in the program, LT's develop positive values, environmental awareness, camping skills and the confidence necessary to make the transition from camper to counselor. It is essential that all LT's attend the entire 8-week program. **Participation in this program does not guarantee being hired as staff. Campers take from the program what they put into it.**

WHAT IS THE ROLE OF THE LT IN THE DAY CAMP PROGRAM?

A. The LT is a camper not a counselor. When LT's are working with campers, they will be assisting. A member of the YMCA staff will always be present and supervising.

B. The LT will meet with the LT supervisor ½ a day, each day. The remainder of the day may be spent in activities or participating in a community service project.

STAFF TRAINING

LT's will be exposed to an extensive training program during camp. Learning opportunities include, but are not limited to pool safety, medical and health problems (what to observe and what to do), fire safety, planning and participation in games and other activities to be used with the campers, trips and community service projects. These sessions will be led by the LT Leader and members of the YMCA staff who have an expertise in leadership programs.

PREREQUISITES

- A completed application demonstrating your interest in the program
- An interview with the Camp Director and/or LT Leader (you will need to schedule an interview)
- Three (3) references. The reference forms should be given to three people (not relatives) who can evaluate your capabilities as a potential counselor. Teachers, scout leaders, family for whom you baby-sat, coach, former employers, etc.
